Collective worship policy

Introduction

The collective worship policy is designed to enable an act of collective worship across the whole Academy. This is addressed through a whole school themed approach.

This is achieved in a number of ways.

1. Thought for the week

Each week a thought or will be published in the Tutor messages. Tutors will then spend two minutes during each tutor session providing students with the opportunity for quiet reflection, discussion, presentation by other students or the tutor based on the 'thought'.

2. Year Assembly

Year assembly will run once a week for each Year (subject to availability of Halls) and will engage students with the thought for the week during the assembly. Where the Hall is unavailable the assembly will be either delivered via TEAMS or by tutors, dependent upon topic.

3. Tutor time Program

Forms meet daily with their Form Tutor and on occasion the Tutor period is used to support activities of reflection and introspection.

4. National events

The academy comes together to mark or celebrate certain events that are important cultural and spiritual moments. Annually Remembrance Day is celebrated through a whole school service. Other significant moments are also recognised such as the passing of Queen Elizabeth II.
