
Welcome to English at Holgate!




A Recipe for a Good Learner

Here is an example line to get you started:


Mix a pinch of creativity with a handful of effort, Add...

Do you dare to share your recipes with the class?


As you listen, be prepared to give some positive feedback about the recipes.

On your worksheet, fill in the first box about what your dream is by the end of Year 7. You may have more than one!






