## C1 Visitors, contractors, and external users of academy premises:

All visitors, contractors and external users to the academy will be asked to bring formal identification with them every time they visit site if they are going to be in regulated activity with pupils.

**Green lanyards** will be issued to visitors, contractors and external users who have been subjected to and successfully completed the necessary checks that satisfy the academy that they can left unaccompanied with pupils.

Where visitors, contractors and external users are not authorised to be left unaccompanied they will be issued with a **red lanyard**.
